

Information for the attendance of a German-class

Please register your child for the elementary or middle school. The school must be located near your home. Important for the registration are the following information: How old is your child? How many years has he/she already attended school in your home country or another country?

If your child speaks German only a little bit, the school will file an application at the school office for your child to attend a German-class.

At the German-classes, the children will get to know children and youths from different countries. Everyone is new in Germany. The goals of these German-classes are:

- Learn German as soon and well as possible
- Integration in Bavaria (for example the values and democracy)
- Preparation for the type of school that is suitable for your child (depends on how your child studies)

At the German-classes students from different years will study together. Usually, they attend a German-class for one year.

In Munich, there are:

- German-classes at elementary schools (Grundschule) for the 2nd and 3rd grade
- German classes regardless of school-type for the 5th and 6th grade at middle schools (Mittelschule), secondary schools (Realschule), high school (Gymnasium) and the municipal orientation level regardless of school type (Städtische schulartunabhängige Orientierungsstufe)
- German-classes for the 7th to 9th grade at middle schools

After your child attends the German-class, it will be decided which school your child will attend after the German-class.

It is also possible that your child attends another scholastic offer of a German-class. That will be decided by the school board.
